

# Special Needs Registry



The Utah Special Needs Registry allows individuals with special needs, disabilities, and functional challenges to provide information to emergency agencies so that they can respond appropriately to serve them in a disaster or other emergency. Individuals on the special needs registry should still take whatever steps they can to prepare for an emergency. - Register for the Utah Special Needs Registry by visiting [www.specialneedsutah.org](http://www.specialneedsutah.org)
  - Click on “Individuals Register Here”
  - Fill out the form with your personal information, making sure to indicate any specific needs
  - You can also dial 2-1-1 to register over the phone
- Create a preparedness plan for those who may require special assistance. Map out evacuation routes and designate a meeting place for family members to gather (refer to “Plan for Family Needs”)
- Make a list or include photos of life-sustaining equipment needed by individuals with special needs (ventilator, supplemental oxygen, vision/hearing aids, wheelchairs, etc.) Make sure these items are easy to access during an emergency
